- Entries must be submitted by email to: competition@cpi-paperworks.org.uk with "Corrugated Competition" in the Subject Line. Entries can be sent at any time up until the deadline of Friday 28 April 2017; entries received after this date will not be accepted.
- If a school wishes to submit more than 20 entries, they must contact CPI prior to entering.
- Actual packaging produced must be to the scale in the brief
- Entries must include the following:
 - o Name of the school with full contact details including email address
 - Name and contact details of the Design and Technology teacher submitting the entries
 - o Name of the student(s) and age(s)
 - o State which design brief has been addressed
 - Suitable photographs. These should be of the design only to a maximum of 5 images, no pictures of students will be accepted. Images must be of reasonable size between 2mb and 5mb. Accepted file formats *.gif, *.jpg or *.pdf
 - o A description of the design in the student's own words, up to a maximum of 250 words
- An industry judging panel will consider all submissions based on the following criteria:
 - how effectively the brief has been met in protecting and presenting the product
 - o has the design made best use of space and used the least material necessary
 - o is the logo and other artwork striking and effective
 - o does the design demonstrate originality and creativity
 - o how practical is the design for manufacture and use

- The judging panel will consider all entries and make a shortlist. Shortlisted schools will then be requested to submit actual models by Friday 19 May 2017 for secondary judging.
- Designs will only be returned upon request.
- Winners will be informed by email on Friday 26 May 2017.
 The judges' decision will be final and no correspondence will be entered into. Prizes/presentations will be made on a mutually agreed date with the winning schools.
- Copyright on all designs submitted will remain with the individual creators.
- Originality of the students' designs will be taken into account by the judges. The organiser reserves the right to disqualify an entry if it is believed the students' design is not their own original work.
